

Will of Jeffrey Holland Pennant - 1775

In the name of God Amen I Jeffrey Holland of Pennant in the parish of Eglwysbach in the County of Denbigh Esquire being in good state of health but of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding do make this my last will and testament touching such temporal and worldly estate which God of his great mercy hath bestowed upon me in manner and form following, that is first to say I devise my body may be decently interred at the discretion of my executrix herein after named and as touching and concerning all and singular my personal estate what so ever of what nature or kind so ever the same since consist of and be and whereof and wherein I shall be possessed of or anywise entitled unto at the time of my decease subject to the payment of my debts and funeral expenses I give leave and bequeath the same and every part and parcel thereof unto my loving wife Mary Holland and to be by her disposed of in such manner and form which uses purposes and intents which she at any time after my decease by deed or will think proper to give leave or dispose of the same and lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife Mary Holland sole executrix of this my last will and testament revoking and cancelling all former wills by me at any time heretofore made and declare this for and as my last will. In witness wherof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the seventh day of January one thousand seven hundred and seventy five.
