## Deed of Sale between Owen Holland & Sir Richard Bulkeley 1595, Referring to Ynys Y Perchill, Merchlyn

To all and Christian people to whom these presents shall come to be seen or understood, I Owen Holland of (Clynyn) in the county of Caernarfon send greetings in our lord God everlasting, know ye me the said Owen Holland for and in consideration of a certain sum of money to me in hand paid by Sir Richard Bulkeley of Beaumaris in the county of Anglesey, knight, have remised released and always for me and my heirs forever quite claimed by these presents unto the said Sir Richard Bulkeley and his heirs forever all my right title claim demense and interest which at any time I have said would have or hereafter may have or in and meadow with the appurtenances called Ynys Y Perchill situate and lying and being in Merchlyn in the township of Castell and the county of Caernarfon aforesaid. So that neither I the said Owen Holland nor my heirs nor any other claiming in my right charge or interest or challenge my title in the said meadow or in any part or parcel of the same. And I the said Owen Holland and my heirs all the said meadow with the appurtenances aforesaid to the use and behoof aforesaid against me the said Owen Holland and my heirs and assigns all other person or persons claiming in by or under my estate tithe or interest against all men will warrant and defend in witness whereof I have here unto put my hand and seal hereon the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September (Anno????? Latin Elizabeth ??????) 1595
